## **1. Organization**

FAI-World CUP and FAI European Championships in PARA SKI 2008 are organised by

- Federation Aeronautique Internationale of Avenue Mon Repos 24, CH 1005 Lausanne, Switzerland (FAI)
- Oesterreichischer Aeroclub (ÖAEC) – Sektion Fallschirmspringen, Prinz Eugen Strasse 12, A-1040, Vienna/Austria (National Member)
- National Aeroclub of Austria Landessektion Steiermark / AQUALIFE-GRAZ, Eduard Peserl, Hermann-Austgasse 17/6, A-8054 Graz/Austria (Organiser)

## **2. Aims of the FCE**

- World Cup winners and European Champions in Para Ski individual – male and female separately,
- World Cup winners and European Champions in Team Para Ski – male and mixed gender teams together and then separately – female teams and junior teams,
- World Cup winners and European Champions in Para Ski Junior (born on or after 01/01/1984 – age of 24) – male and female separately,
- World Cup winner and Winner of the European Masters Class Para Ski (born on or before 31/12/1958 – age of 50) – male and female separately.

## **3. Date and place of the FCE**

05 – 09 March 2008 in Donnersbachwald / Riesneralm – Styria – Austria.

## **4. General Information**

Participation:

**World Cup:**

Unlimited number of teams (4 members) per nation. Teams of mixed gender are allowed.

**European Championships:**

3 teams (4 members) per nation: teams of mixed gender are allowed. This gives a maximum of 12 participants per nation with a maximum of 8 male or female competitors. Additional one team (4 members) per nation with, juniors – mixed gender are allowed. (Juniors – see Pt. 2.)

Training jumps: Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2008 from 10.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m., and Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2008 from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.. The jumps must be booked in advance (official entry form), the fee is € 30,00 for each jump.

Training slalom: There is no official slalom training. Each team can organize a ski training by itself with the technical support of the organizing local ski-club.

Aircraft: Ecureuil or similar helicopter (4 parachutists) with an exit speed of approx. 60 – 80 kts

Personal requirements: To take part in the event, a valid FAI Sport License 2008, is requested. For the slalom competition the rigid helmet is compulsory. Each participating country should also bring a national flag (size: 100 cm x 150 cm) and a tape/CD with the national anthem for the opening ceremony.

Insurance requirements: Each competitor should have accident insurance valid; the minimum amount of coverage required in Austria by law is € 1.500.000,00. Liability insurance, covering Officials, Judges, etc., will be arranged by the Organizer. The immediate medical First Aid to the participants is the responsibility of the Organizer during the official event, including training days.

Accommodations: The name and other details about the hotels, where the teams will be on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> or Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> (depend on the arriving), will be communicated to the Head of Delegation during the registration at the Office “Talstation Riesneralm” Donnersbachwald

Transport: Delegations are responsible for their own transportation to Donnersbachwald. Transfers in Donnersbachwald can be arranged and must be booked in advance, if you don't have a own car – but it is a 5 minute walk to the ski area and to the drop zone.

### Entry fees

- **The provisional entry form must be submitted before December, 21<sup>th</sup> 2007**
- **The official entry form must reach the organizer no later than January, 20<sup>th</sup> 2008**

The entry fees must be paid within a week after the official entry deadline (28<sup>th</sup> January 2008). The receipt has to be presented Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> March before 5.00 p.m., will be issued by the organizing committee as soon as the payment through the bank is completed.

- Late entries are accepted until Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2008 at 4.00 p.m. with a penalty of € 50,00 per person.
- Late payments are accepted until Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2008 at 5.00 p.m. with a penalty of € 50,00 per person.

If the two described situations happen together, the organizing committee will apply max € 50,00 of penalty per person.

The delegations that did not pay the entry fees in time, are not allowed to take part in the competition.
